

## KYLE POLICE REPORT FOR AMBERWOOD COMMUNITY

July through September, 2007

Compiled by Craig Wiseman and Mike Rubsam, Amberwood Safety Committee

- 39 incidents of non-specific police investigations.
- 23 incidents of animal disturbances.
- 3 incidents of domestic disturbances.
- 3 incidents of criminal property mischief.
- 20 incidents of disorderly conduct.
- 15 incidents of vehicle stops.
- 4 incidents of burglary of vehicle. Animal disturbances continue to represent a large percentage

of police responses to our Amberwood neighborhood and attacks by loose dogs have killed or injured several pets and threatened numerous residents during the past year. Residents are urged to properly secure their animals and please keep them quiet. Should you observe any loose animal in the neighborhood please act immediately to notify the authorities and warn your neighbors if you feel that it is necessary. Get to know the people
